- **Date:** June 16th to 17th 2026
- **Location and Venue:** Helsinki (Urban Environment House (KYMP-talo), Työpajankatu 8, Helsinki)
- **Audience:** PCP WISE buyers, their end users, suppliers, and members of the SOG
- **Duration:** 1.5 days

Objectives - what can you expect?

- **Capacity Sharing:** An opportunity to connect with the rest of PCP WISE suppliers, buyers, and end users from all across Europe and exchange on topics such as user friendliness, the expectations and outcomes of Phase 2 of the PCP, and best practices and pain points to build guide the development of the solutions in Phase 2 and give insights on how they can best meet the needs of buyers and end users.
- **PCP ACADEMY training on Earth Observation (EO)-based water risk services:** This technical workshop for suppliers and buyers will focus on the capabilities needed to develop EO-based services address water-related climate risks. It will give attendees insight into the EO data processing chain, including the use of tools (e.g., GMTSAR or SNAP–StaMPS) for deriving satellite-based information. The training will demonstrate how EO-derived products can be integrated into hydrological modelling frameworks, including coupling with models such as STEMMUS-SCOPE, and incorporated into digital twin environments and decision-support workflows.
- **Ensuring PCP WISE works for you:** Based on results of the M10 workshop, we continue to discuss potential barriers as well as supporting factors for the adoption of the PCP WISE solutions by users. Now, with better knowledge of the developed solutions, we will discuss their specific characteristics and where we foresee potential problems for the implementation of these solutions.
- **Learning and Sensemaking:** Interactive and creative elements – such as a physical PCP WISE timeline to visualise big deadlines and where input is needed – that facilitate networking interactions between buyers, users, suppliers, and partners, enabling them to learn from each other and share best practices.
